Billecart-Salmon Le Clos Saint-Hilaire 1998 412
Champagne, France
The 1998 Brut Le Clos Saint-Hilaire emerges from the glass with an exotic array of intensely perfumed, candied fruit. The wine possesses gorgeous textural richness in a deep, layered expression of Pinot Noir. The mousse remains refined and very elegant all the way through to the deeply satisfying, resonating finish... The Billecart-Salmon house style is defined by class, elegance, and a sublime freshness to the wines. Long fermentations at cold temperatures with no malolactic fermentation are the rule at this small, family-owned property in Mareuil-sur-Ay. 95 points Robert Parker's *The Wine Advocate* (12/2009)

Penedes, Spain
Part of a projected series of late-disgorged wines from this greatest of cava producers, this was aged on lees for 12 years. Eschewing Parellada for the longer-lived and more structured Xarel-lo (75%) and Macabeu varieties, this is still remarkably fresh. The zero dosage bestows a dry palate with leesy, nutty notes and a broad soft acidity from this warm vintage additionally contributing ripe yellow fruit notes.

Marguet Blanc de Noirs NV Premier Cru 72
Champagne, France
Benoit Marguet is a new kid on the block in Champagne and handles with **great dexterity his family's vines, all of which are farmed with meticulous care** and respect for the environment. This cuvée is made from black grapes only, 70% pinot noir and 30% pinot meunier. The style is full, rich and beautifully rounded. A lovely Champagne that can be drunk with ease, with or without food.

Loire Valley, France
From cask, Dagueneau's 2011 Blanc Fume de Pouilly whose lots had already been assembled in the press, offers a radish-like aromatic prickle and palate bite along with piquancy of citrus pip, all of which, I predict, will put it in good stead to deliver from bottle a sense of vivacity and invigoration that are not easy to come by in this vintage. A true gem in this vineyard area which stretches across both the Chassagne and Puligny communes, the terroir of this very particular Grand Cru is composed of brown marly limestone soils with oolite and scree from the middle-Bathonian era.	
This Montrachet Grand Cru offers us a very beautiful crystalline pale yellow robe with intense straw-yellow reflections. Rich, very refreshing, long and progressive, the nose develops balsamic notes with a mixture of white fruit: almonds, spices with hints of vanilla and coconut. Very round and full-bodied, this wine possesses a harmonious balance between its mineral structure and its great persistence.	
Domaine de Roally Vire-Clesse 2012 Burgundy, France	40
One of the most distinctive Chardonnays in all of Burgundy, Domaine de Roally's style is not shy; theirs are low-yield, late-harvested Chardonnays that are not afraid to carry a touch of heft to amplify the wine's mineral expressions. Roally's 2012 Viré-Clessé casts a bold golden color from the glass with aromas of honeycomb, bee pollen, raw cashews and smoky minerals. Rich and mouth-filling, the wine fuses suggestions of quince paste, apricots and ripe yellow apples with refreshing acidity and a firm mineral spine. Long and smoky on the finish, the wine's rich core of yellow fruits coats the palate while its acidity and oyster-shell mineral energy simultaneously enliven it. The aromas here are like nothing you've ever experienced. The exotic mango, papaya, coconut, and pineapple introduce a sweet wine — or so you would think. However, it turns out to be bone-dry.	
Domaine de L'Alliance " Sauve des eaux " 2012 Bordeaux, France	57
These are the grapes that made it far enough to make a "sweet wine," but not close to the level of concentration one would need for a Sauternes. This wine has a profile closer to a Vouvray Moelleux. You'll find the aromas very Sauternes-like but without the same concentration or level of residual sugar. The result is a wine with the character of Sauternes that is much more versatile at the table.	
Zind-Humbrecht Riesling "Clos Saint Urbain" 2013 Alsace, France <i>Grand Cru Rangen</i>	102
The nose is unmistakable Rangen, showing intense flinty, aromatic herbal aromas. The palate is rich and powerful with good balance.	
The Rangen Grand Cru's unique terroir, with opposing influences of high altitude (slowing ripening) yet warm volcanic soils and dramatically steep slope with best exposure (speeding it up), cultivates optimal ripeness.

Thank the folks at Pewsey Vale for aging this stellar wine five years before its release. The result is what Australian Rieslings aspire to become, a medium-bodied wine of uncommon elegance. The 2012 Pinot Noir Bergstrom Vineyard was planted in 1998 and 1999 and the 2012 saw a great deal of whole-cluster fruit. It has a well-defined and characterful bouquet with subtle floral scents, red plum, wild strawberry and a touch of dried blood. The palate is medium-bodied with a superb savory-tinged entry, a subtle dash of spice and wonderful tension. There is a sense of completeness here and complexity that is outstanding and it lingers long after the wine has departed. PROPRIETARY RED

Bond is the extraordinary project of Harlan Estate's proprietor, Bill Harlan. In essence, what he does along with his winemaker, Bob Levy, and his team, is to identify outstanding vineyard sites in specific viticultural regions of Napa Valley, sign the owners to long-term (20 years) leases, and produce essentially 100% Cabernet Sauvignon wines from these sites. All of these offerings represent world-class Cabernet Sauvignons from Napa meant to endure 30 or more years of cellaring should one have the patience to wait that long. There are five separate vineyard sites in the Bond portfolio.

Bond Quella 2010 375ml 375
Napa Valley, California
The 2010 Quella is a candidate for perfection. From the lower foothills of Pritchard Hill, it offers up notes of charcoal, graphite, espresso and copious quantities of blueberry and black raspberry liqueur, along with distinctive minerality, a full-bodied mouthfeel, moderately high tannins, gorgeous richness and a long, moderately tannic finish. Forget it for five years and drink it over the following three decades.

The 2010 Vecina is the most explosive wine in this range. At the same time, though, the 2010 is incredibly closed down. Iron, smoke, tobacco and new leather add complexity to a core of seriously intense dark red fruit. Rich, powerful and totally beguiling, the 2010 shows off massive depth and pure power. Readers will have to be patient. Vecina emerges from a single parcel within Vine Hill Ranch, one of the top sites in Oakville. The Vecina is a bit reticent today compared to last year. I don't exclude the possibility that it reaches the sublime level of the St. Eden.

It has a splendid bouquet of smoke, pencil lead, tar, espresso, blueberry, and blackberry. On the palate it remains an infant developmentally with full, ripe tannin, gobs of fruit, and great length. It needs a minimum of 10-12 years of cellaring and will drink well through 2040."

Araujo Eisele Cabernet Sauvignon 2011 1000
Napa Valley, California
A chateau-style estate in the northeast Napa Valley, Araujo consists of the 41-acre Eisele Vineyard and a winery/cave complex designed specifically to vinify these grapes. Established in the late 1800s, Eisele is one of Napa Valley's most respected Cabernet Sauvignon vineyards.
The Eisele Vineyard terroir showed its pedigree in 2011. This Cabernet is vibrant and fresh, layered with distinctive minerality and nuance. The ethereal tannins are simply melted throughout, supporting a delicious texture and prolonged by a lingering finish. The 2011 Eisele Vineyard Cabernet combines deep energy and elegance with a sense of restraint, providing great pleasure even at this early stage of its life.

Year-in and year-out this is one of the most interesting and fascinating group of wines and projects in Napa Valley. First, Schrader has two committed owners, secondly a brilliant winemaker in Thomas Brown, and thirdly, one of the true first-growth vineyard sites in all of Napa Valley, the famed Beckstoffer-owned To Kalon Vineyard in Oakville.

Schrader LPV Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 750

In its third vintage, the Schrader LPV is truly coming into its own. A combination of incredible weather mixed with a deeper knowledge of the Beckstoffer Las Piedras vineyard has led to this remarkable vintage of Schrader LPV. The entry of this wine offers a luxurious wave of deep, dark black and blue fruit aromas and flavors woven with layers of stunning crushed rock minerality and elegant notes of lead pencil shavings, loamy soil, sweet tobacco, incense, and forest floor. The wine is tremendously complex, beautifully balanced, and offers an expansive Cabernet profile.

"2010 is a beautifully balanced wine; from a season that was perfect in many ways. I could sit and savour the nose on this wine for hours; exotic spices, sage, pepper and rich layers of blackberry, plum and cedar. These amazing old vines really delivered in this year, with a complex palate of dark brooding flavours, texture and refined silky tannins with incredible length" fifth generation Henschke winemaker Stephen Henschke.
Very deep crimson with violet hues. An alluring nose of exotic spices, cracked black pepper, licorice, sage and crushed herbs, complemented by sweeter notes of blackberry, plum and cedar. The complex palate has dark, brooding flavors, rich layers, texture and balance of natural acidity, while the refined, silky tannins provide exceptional length.

This is a blend of 80% Syrah, 7% Petite Sirah, 6% Mourvèdre, 3.5% Touriga Nacional and 3.5% Viognier, fermented with 28% whole clusters and aged 25 months in 65% new French oak. It's full-bodied, beautifully layered, silky and seamless, with no hard edges and wonderful freshness in both the aromatics and palate. Give bottles 3-4 years and enjoy over the following 10-15.

There's a mysteriously attractive aromatic profile to this winery's top-end Syrah bottling, with violet perfume blending into blueberry syrup, anise and spearmint. The flavors are bold but not over the top, with lavender, dried berry leather and espresso combining into a seriously memorable wine. 92 points *Wine Enthusiast* (3/2015)

Wirra Wirra's flagship Shiraz has won many accolades over the years, including the 'world's best Shiraz'. Deep crimson purple, both the bouquet and palate command immediate attention exhibiting a near-perfect paradigm for McLaren Vale Shiraz. Medium to full bodied, but without any obvious alcohol warmth it has an unbroken stream of black fruits, licorice, dark chocolate, cedary oak and fine, ripe tannins, the balance line and length reflect the very good vintage and equally good winemaking.

Red Schooner Voyage #2 Mendoza, Argentina Shipped chilled to Napa Valley from Mendoza this Malbec was produced in the Wagner Family "Caymus" style. A dense, dark red, this wine opens up with the scent of ripe plums and cherries, layered with hints of baking chocolate. On the palate, it is powerful, concentrated, supple and persistent. This wine is unfinned and may throw a bit of sediment, representing the rich and natural concentration of abundant quality.	69
Sine Qua Non Grenache 2013 Sonoma Coast, California Manfred's 2013 Grenache Female checks in as a blend of 78% Grenache, 19% Syrah and 3% Mourvèdre that is mostly from his Eleven Confessions estate vineyard in Sta. Rita Hills, yet has smaller portions from his Cumulus, The Third Twin and Bien Nacido vineyards. Seeing just over 24 months in a mix of demi-muids, 300-liter Hog Heads and barrique, it has a sensational bouquet of spring flowers, black raspberries, black cherries, violets, licorice and camphor. Reminding me of a great vintage of Raymond Usseglio's Cuvée Imperiale, this full-bodied, elegant Grenache is impeccably balanced, has a full and layered mid-palate and sweet tannin on the finish. It's almost impervious to air and didn't budge an inch over the three days I followed this bottle.
